**BRIEF SYNOPSIS OR OUTLINE OF DISCUSSION:** The Police Department will present information on the outcome of the in-depth RFP process conducted in 2019 for a new body worn and in car camera system.

The department will then present information on Canton's patrol statistics and discuss correlated programs currently in place.

**DESIRED SESSION OUTCOME:** 1) To educate the Board of Trustees on the current and recommended camera systems for the police department.

2) To provide the Board of Trustees with transparent patrol statistical data, and educate them on the variety of programs and direction being provided by the Police Department.
